Work on the Springvale Road Rail Separation Project at Nunawading is on track and progressing quickly.

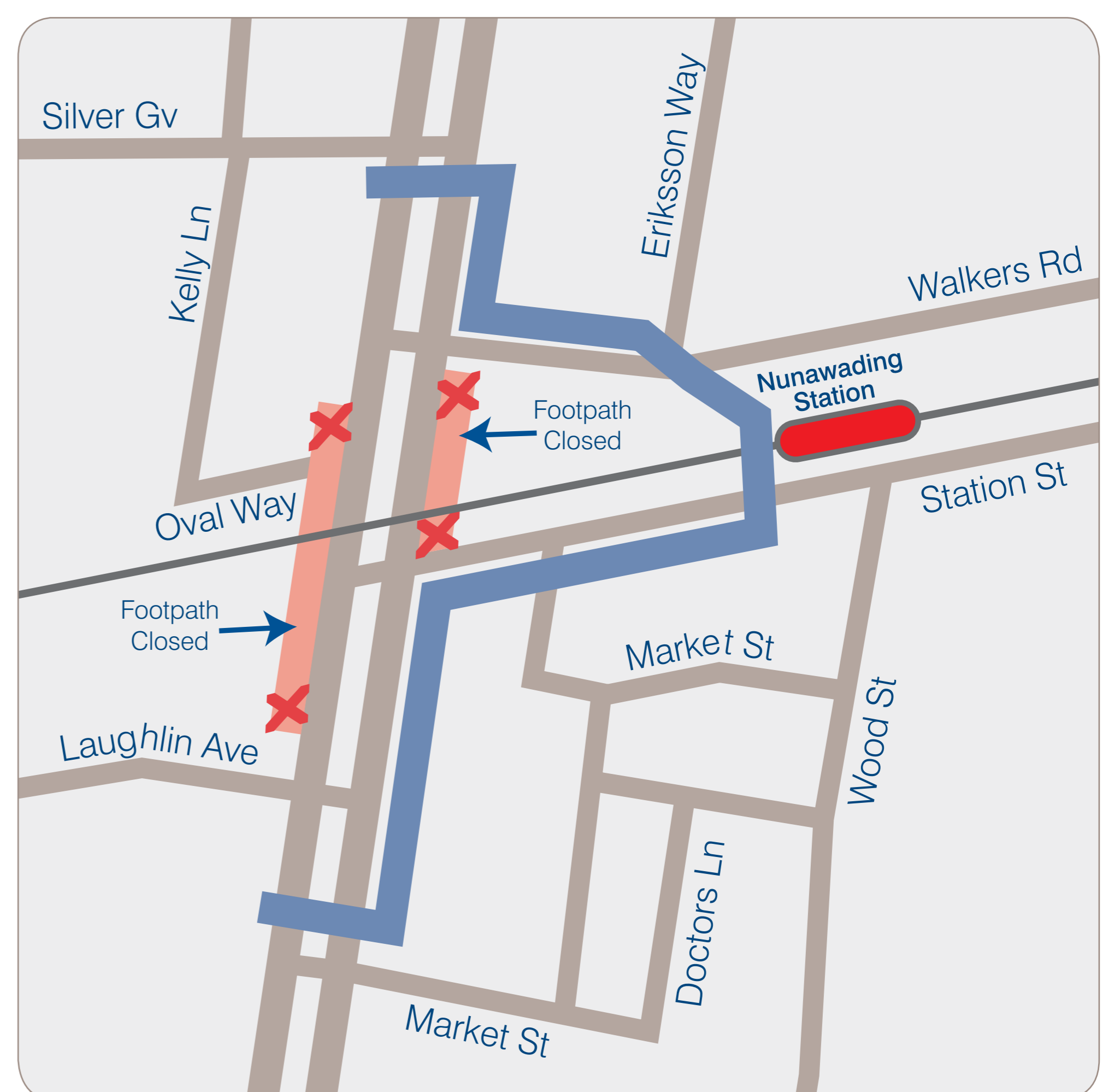
To protect the safety of pedestrians and allow major works to proceed, pedestrian access across the level crossing on the east side footpath of Springvale Road will close from 6am on Thursday 13 August until works are finished in early 2010.

The pedestrian crossing at the Nunawading Station and bus stop on Station Street will remain open throughout the project.

Signs at key locations and a temporary painted blue line will help guide people safely around the level crossing, Nunawading shops and station area.

Everyone is urged to follow the blue line to safely get across the train tracks and Springvale Road.
